SUPPORT AND SAFETY

YFU study abroad creates meaningful opportunities for self-discovery and growth. Experienced Admissions Counselors help you select the program that is right for you and answer your predeparture questions. Orientations are held to prepare you for your journey and continue while abroad. Most programs include round-trip domestic and international travel as well as airport assistance at international gateways. You are placed with a carefully screened host family, enrolled in a school (semester or year programs) and have access to counseling, tutoring and worldwide emergency assistance around the clock.
